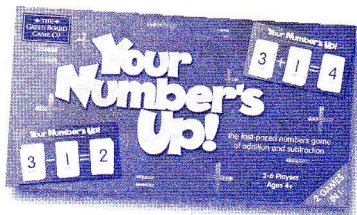


# Your Number's Up!



## Addition game:

1. Place the game board with the "addition" side facing up.
2. Shuffle the cards and deal each player 7 cards. Place the spare cards by the side of the board.
3. The youngest player starts and play follows in a clockwise direction.
4. The first player places a card on any of the three positions.
5. The next player places a card on either of the remaining two positions.
6. The next player must try to complete the sum.
7. A player who completes the sum takes the cards as a "trick" and restarts the next sum.
8. The game ends when a player is the first to place his/her last card or all spare cards have been taken.

Please note that the total of the sum cannot be higher than 20 as this is the highest number card.

## Wild Card:

A player placing a Wild card must declare its value when playing the card. If a player cannot go but has a Wild card they must play it.

## If a player cannot go:

A player who cannot go picks up a card from the spare pile and play passes to the next player. A card that has been picked up cannot be played until it is the player's next turn.

## Scoring:

At the end of each game each player counts up his/her points. Each trick counts as 5 points. The player who finishes first also scores an extra 10 points. Any players having cards left at the end of the game should count up the 'number' of cards (not the value) they have left and subtract this number from their score.

Games can be played individually or the final winner can be the first person to reach a certain score e.g. 100 points.

## Subtraction game:

As for Addition game except have the "subtraction" side of the game board facing up.

## For younger players:

Play the games as above but only use cards numbered 0 to 10 and four of the Wild cards!
